Sliding scale available; Medi-Cal and insurance accepted. Undocumented patients accepted. Teen center: free, confidential reproductive services offered to people between ages 12 and 26.

Alliance in Healdsburg and in Windsor can see you quickly- often in the next 1-3 days. They are taking new patients. They offer all aspects of reproductive health. Many of their appointments will be via telehealthsome in person appointments. They will sign you up for FPACT if you are income eligible.

Drop in. Mon & Wed 2:30pm-5:00pm, Tues.12:30pm-5:00pm, Thurs 2:30pm-7:00pm. Services free for adolescents up through 25 years old. Confidential family planning, STD/HIV testing and treatment, pregnancy testing, emergency contraception, free condoms, mental health counseling, peer education.

TEEN CLINIC sees you up to age 25! Telehealth appointments on Monday and Tuesdays. Phones are answered later in the week. They can sign you up for FPACT over the phone. They can call in lab orders for STI testing, order medications, etc. SRJC Student Health Nurse Practitioners (NPs) are available to assist you in many ways.

For sexual health services, the NPs can offer phone advice or Telelhealth ZOOM appointments.

We can re-order order Emergency Contraception (Plan B), re-order birth control, order lab work for possible Sexually Transmitted Infection exposure, medicines for STIs or vaginal infections, treat urinary tract infections and counsel you as to the next best step. If we can't help you, we know the local resources that can help you.

Of note- Emergency contraception is covered by FPACT and most insurances. You can also get it directly from the pharmacy without an order. It costs \$39-55 if you don't have insurance.
