- Adults and Youth (12 years old and above), men & women, bilingual/bicultural Spanish available.
- Individual and group counseling for individuals and families.
- Accepts private pay, Medi-Cal/Minor Consent Medi-Cal

Bright Heart Health (Telehealth)

- Resources, videos, and individual/group therapy for substance addiction.
- Accepts most major insurances and Medi-Cal, Medicare, and Medicaid
